



ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admissions open for the academic year 2023-2024 **Nursery, Lower Kindergarten, Upper Kindergarten, Grade 1 to 12**
2. Registration Fee is Rs. 3000
3. Parents interested in seeking admission of their wards may fill up the "Admission Form" and along with it submit the required documents as mentioned in the "Enclosure" section of the "Admission Form"
4. Admission to **Nursery, Lower Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten** will be granted on the **basis of the child's age, written CLA and oral interaction with the child.**
5. The Applicants seeking admission to **Grades 1 to 12 will be required to appear for a Competency Level Assessment(CLA)**. The purpose of CLA is to assess the grade for which the child is suitable rather than to grant/refuse admission. This also helps in identifying the baseline level of the student at the time of the admission.
6. Admission will be confirmed on receipt of fee for the first instalment along with the admission fee.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

1. Age Eligibility:

4. **Transportation:**

School buses pick up students from centralized points along the major roads. The precise location of the pickup points will depend on the residential locations of the majority users. Safety of children is our priority; a conductor and a lady attendant accompany children on all routes. For the safety and security of the children, all school buses are fitted with surveillance cameras. The school buses are also equipped with Global Positioning System (GPS) which enables parents to track the locations of the bus.
